When he was only nine years old, Satish Kumar renounced the world and joined the wandering brotherhood of Jain monks. 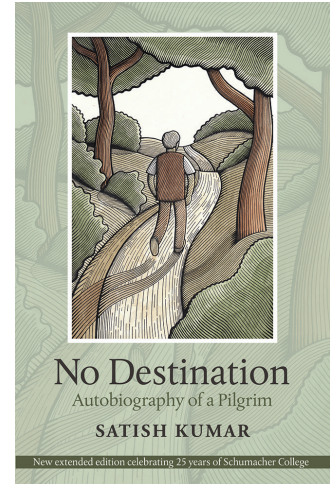
